This designation is awarded upon completion of the following requirements:

1. Foundation Training Certificate of Completion

- Completion of the pre-covid in-person Foundation Training OR
- Completion of the post-covid online Foundation Training and 4-day in-person Touch Intensive

2. Personal NATouch Therapy Sessions

- 6 sessions — In person when possible

3. Aline's Study Group

- 8 meetings • 3½ hrs each • 28 hours total either live or recorded • for meeting dates [click here](#)

4. Case Consultations

5. Case Study

- One written Case Study using NATouch and somatic principles:
 - We ask for a written case study because touch practitioners do not let their transformative work be known and consequently somatic and touch work remains largely invisible to the larger fields of psychotherapy and psychiatry. Written case studies provide important educational material that helps people understand how somatic work and the therapeutic use of touch offer important contributions to the process of healing change.
