Practitioner Program

If you are interested in continuing your NATouch journey, the **NeuroAffective Touch Practitioner Program** (NATP) is a self-paced, self-directed program designed to enhance your individual practice and specialties.

The Practitioner designation is required to:

- ◆ Become an approved session provider
 - ◆ Become an approved individual consult provider
 - ◆ Lead ongoing closed consult groups
 - ◆ Progress to the faculty track
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The designation of **NeuroAffective Touch Practitioner (NATP)** is granted upon meeting the following requirements:

1 Foundation Training Graduate

☐ **In-Person Part 1 + Part 2**

Two 6-day Modules — 12 days total

☐ **Hybrid Online / In-Person**

Modules 1, 2, 3 — online + 3 cohort consults + 3 practice exchanges

Module 4 Touch Immersion — 5 days in-person

2 Personal Therapy Sessions

- ☐ **Eight personal sessions with an approved session provider**—*Session fees not included in the tuition*
The Foundation Training personal sessions do not count towards the Practitioner requirements

- ◆ The fee is based on a 50-minute session paid directly to the provider
- ◆ Each session, regardless of length, counts as one session toward your requirement. The session length and fee adjustments should be agreed upon before the session begins
- ◆ When possible, at least one personal session should be attended in person
- ◆ The discounted fees above apply only to the 8-session requirement. Afterward, the provider's regular fees apply. Providers charge the standard fees for the country where they practice

3 Practicums

Attend live or prerecorded on-demand Practicums of your choice, each lasting 3½ hours — equivalent to a half-day training. A wide range of Practicums on specialized topics is available, with new options added regularly.

☐ **Eight Practicums** ▪ 3½ hrs each ▪ 28 hours total

- ◆ Practicums may be attended live online or recorded
- ◆ To count towards the Practitioner Certificate, Practicums require a 500-word Reflection
- ◆ \$125^{USD} each — 15% discount package purchase of three or more

4 Case Consultations

☐ **Twelve consult credits with an approved consult provider**

- ◆ **Individual** — 2 credits per consult
- ◆ **Mentored Hands** — 2 credits per consult
- ◆ **Small Group** — 1 credit per consult
- ◆ **Ongoing Closed Group** — 1 credit per meeting

5 Case Study

We require a written case study because therapeutic touch remains largely invisible to the broader fields of psychotherapy and psychiatry. Written case studies provide essential educational materials that demonstrate how somatic therapy and the therapeutic use of touch significantly contribute to the therapeutic process.

Completed case studies are posted in the **Documents** section of our password-protected **NATouch Forum**. Access is restricted to graduates, practitioners, and active students.
